TRANSFER SLATON RIOTERS.

Militia Delivers Them to Civil Authorities for Trial.

ATLANTA, Ga., June 29. — Georgia civil authorities assumed jurisdiction today over the cases of the twenty-six men arrested by the militia Saturday near ex-Governor Slaton's home, after demonstrations against the commutation of Leo M. Frank's sentence. The decision not to try the cases by military court was reached at a conference by Adjt. Gen. Nash, Solicitor Dorsey, and Judge Hill of the Superior Court.

No formal charges have been made against the prisoners. The four men arrested near the Slaton estate yesterday were released today.
