

SENATE COMMITTEE GETS A FAVORABLE REPORT

Senate Committee on Census With All but One Vote, Recommends That the Senate Make Speedy Confirmation OPPOSITION TO GEORGIAN IS ONLY POLITICAL MOVE

Nothing in Opposition to Reflect on His Competency—Republicans Only Move to Hold Durand in Office

BY HARRY BRUCE WASHINGTON, D. C., April 20.—The opposition of William C. Durand, director of the census, received a hard sell this morning when the census committee adopted a report recommending Mr. Durand's speedy confirmation.

Only one vote was cast against the Durand report. Senator Charles McNary of Michigan, who has headed an unsuccessful movement to hold on to the post against Mr. Durand, will file a minority report in order to delay the confirmation of Mr. Durand.

Mr. McNary's report was made a hard and consistent fight for the confirmation of Mr. Durand. The action of the senate committee this morning reflects the sentiment of the Georgia, neither of which is a member of the census commission.
