SUFFRAGETTES IN CHURCH AND PLACED BOMB IN BIG HOTEL

St. Catherine's, the Parish Church of Hatcham, in the Southeast of London, Is Destroyed by Flames Tuesday

THE LIFE OF THE... BUT LEFT ATLANTA IN THE SOUTHERN... WASN'T BEEN BORN

Negative Alibi Sooner Established for Young Man Held in Texas City as Suspected Murderer of Mary Phagan in Atlanta—Police There Say 'Strong Evidence,' but Nothing Shows Young Man Was Around Here April 26

BROTHER, IN NEWMAN, SAYS PAUL HAS BEEN IN HOUSTON SIX WEEKS; OUT WEST SINCE OCTOBER

Two Friends, Young Men in Atlanta, Report Recent Letters From Him—Brother Has Had One-So Has Father—Detectives Say Quinn Changed His Story—New Le Declares Murder Must Have Occurred During the Afternoon

A negative alibi established for Paul P. Bowen by several authorities, among whom are his brother and his father in Newman, seems to clear the young man arrested Monday night in Houston, Tex., from any suspicious connection with the murder of Mary Phagan in Atlanta on the night of April 24.

Strong evidence against the man whom they have arrested and are holding (at request of the Atlanta police) as a suspect, is reported by the police of Houston in telegrams to the Atlanta police. One dispatch said they found a photograph of Mary Phagan in the young man's trunk.

Another says they found three, too, a girl's vest, with blood on it, letters from Atlanta signed "Mary," and other initials "M. P.," or "M. J. P.," are described among other finds in the trunk. A woman's shirt, "blood-stained and full of holes," was found in the attic back of the hotel where Bowen had been stopping, just before he moved to the boarding house where the police arrested him.

The suspicion of a woman whose room, adjacent to that of Bowen in the hotel, led the police to him, she saw the man's suitcase on the stairs of the Mary Phagan murder, the dispatch says, and heard him moan that he wished he hadn't "done it," and that if he had had life to live over he would not make the same mistake, or work to that effect.

LEFT HERE LAST FALL. Yet there remains the fact that in no way does the Journal's searching and thorough investigation connect Bowen with Atlanta. Friends and relatives of Bowen say that he has not been in Georgia so far as they know since last October. Charles Kimball, of the Southern Under Machinery Co. at Dallas, Texas, reports receiving a letter from Bowen, dated at Houston, April 25. The young man's father reports a postal card from him there recently. Paul's brother says he has not seen him in Houston, or in Texas, since he was arrested. Bowen has been seen in Atlanta or Georgia recently, so far as appears; and has been reported to have been stopped for the last six weeks as a suspect, traveling with the general manager of a certain railroad in Texas, July in Houston.
