(By Associated Press.)

CONSTANTINOPLE, Turkey, July 10.—Surrendering to the Turks, Bulgaria regarding their future frontier has been a constant theme. The Ottoman government has been demanding that they evacuate the territory from Enos, on the Aegean coast, to Midia, on the Black sea. Otherwise, the Turks would drive them out of Bulgaria. The note permitted no time for reply.

General Ismet Pasha, commander-in-chief of the Turkish army, has left for the front.
