WASHINGTON, July 25.—In spite of the manifold sensational headlines which the country is reading in the Nation's papers since the return of Ambassador Whitney to the United States, the Journal has high authority for the statement that nothing has occurred to corroborate any of them.

### PRESENTS BILL TO GIVE MOTHER CHILD'S CUSTODY

Much Favorable Sentiment for Measure to Give Mother Rights to Minor Children

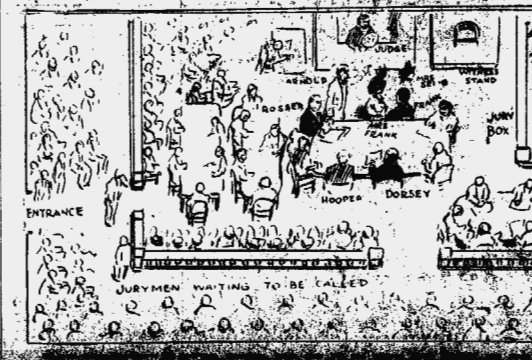

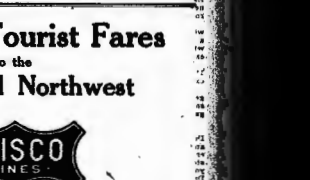
