30,000 SUFFRAGISTS, LED BY SOUTHERN WOMAN, HIKE THROUGH HEART OF GOTHAM

Mrs. Richard Burleson Heads Great "Votes for Women" Army Up Fifth Avenue--While Zouaves Dance--Police Keep Perfect Order.

NEW YORK, May 3.--With the precision of soldiers 30,000 women suffragists and men sympathizers marched through the heart of New York city this afternoon in the most wonderful and brilliant "votes for women" demonstration ever held in North America.

Between 75,000 and 100,000 persons were massed along Fifth Avenue and a thunder of cheers greeted the marchers all along the line. There was no disorder. Twelve hundred foot and mounted police lined the route and those who attempted to interfere with the procession met the staid forceful resistance.
