

SHOTS NOT FOR SLATON.

Georgia Authorities Say There was
No Attack Upon Ex-Governor.

ATLANTA, Ga., Oct. 31.—Fulton County authorities have decided that shots heard early today in the neighborhood of the country home of former Governor John M. Slaton were fired by a passing automobile party or by possum hunters.

On account of threats made when Mr. Slaton commuted the death sentence of Leo M. Frank, watchmen have kept guard over his home since he returned from a Western trip several weeks ago.
